We are constantly evaluating our selection to choose the best tasting and most reliable varieties for our area. We also try to include some of the newer varieties, such as the new Peacotum 'Bella Gold', and the dwarf Zaiger cherry rootstock. Recently we have discontinued the traditional Bartlett and Comice pears because of fire blight problems. Blake's Pride and Warren are both excellent tasting pears with fire blight resistance.

If you have fears about the amount of space for a backyard orchard check out our fruit bush training guide. This technique allows you to plant fruit trees in amazingly small areas. An eight tree fruit bush hedge can be planted in an area only 4'x16'. By reducing tree height, you can do all the pruning, thinning and picking from the ground!

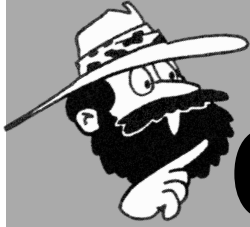
BLUEBERRY - POTTED

| Misty (Potted) | \$26.98 | July. Self-Fertile, but need two varieties for best production. |
| Ozark Blue (Potted) | \$26.98 | July. Self-Fertile, but need two varieties for best production. |
| Pink Lemonade (Potted) | \$26.98 | Mid Late to Late Season. New variety with pink fruit. |
| Sharpblue (Potted) | \$26.98 | Early-Midseason. Fruit is medium to large, medium blue in color. Average firmness with good flavor. |
